Northville Downs Celebrates 100 Years of Horse Racing in 2011!

Big changes await Northville horse racing fans this season... Northville Downs Race Track has completed an upgrade to the facility that includes the addition of 350 brand new flat panel television sets on every table of the second and third levels of the Clubhouse. The complex also added 11 new big screen television sets mounted overhead giving patrons a panoramic view of the live and simulcast action. Private wagering terminals are also available on the second level of the Clubhouse. In addition to the interior changes, a complete overhaul of the website has been completed: www.northvilledowns.com. New to the website this year will be the addition of live video streaming and also video replays.

To celebrate the 100 year anniversary, fans will have an opportunity to win \$100,000 in cash every live racing night with Royal Flush Friday's and Super Seven Saturday's promotions. Dollar Night will be back every Friday night \$1 hot dogs, soft drinks, popcorn, live programs and live wagering; draft beer on Fridays will be reduced to \$2.

Finally, the wagering format has been adjusted slightly. Northville Downs will still be offering 50 cent Trifectas and Dime Superfectas on all races nightly, but added two Pick Three's to the racing card and a Pick Four on the last four races on every program.

The live racing schedule is every Friday and Saturday with post time at 7 p.m. Northville Downs is located at 301 S. Center Street (corner of Seven Mile Road).

Tax Department

If you have just purchased a home, Michigan law states that you have 45 days from the date of purchase to file a Property Transfer Affidavit. Commercial and Residential Properties:

March 1st – Assessment Notices are mailed the end of February. If you have not received your assessment notice by March 1st, values are available online at the City’s website (www.ci.northville.mi.us) click on Services, Tax & Assessing, then the Data Look-up button or contact the City Assessor’s Office at (248) 449-9901.

Through March 16th – The Board of Review meets for the purpose of reviewing the Assessment Rolls and hearing petitioner appeals in March. You must have an appointment to be heard by the Board of Review. Appointments can be made by contacting the Assessing Office at (248) 449-9901 after March 1st.

Residential Properties:

May 1st - Principal Residence Exemption Date. The taxpayer must own and occupy the property as their primary residence as of May 1st to receive the 18 mill exemption from school operating tax.

City Wide Sidewalk Repairs

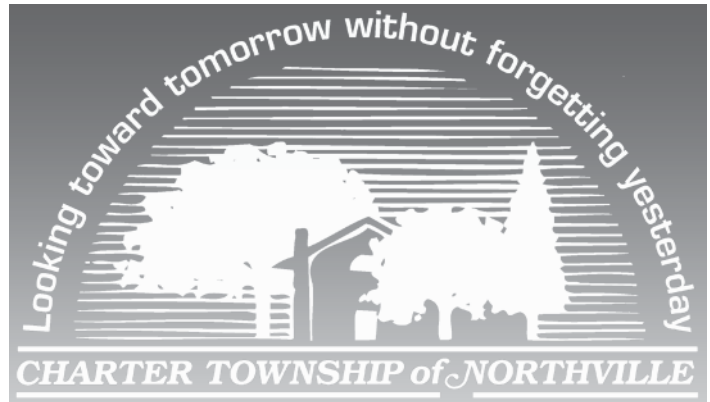
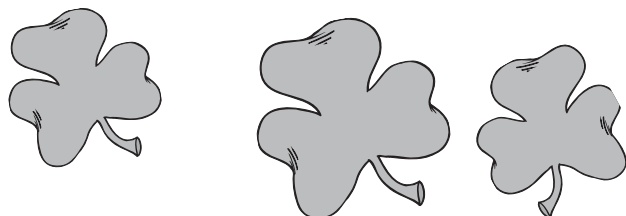

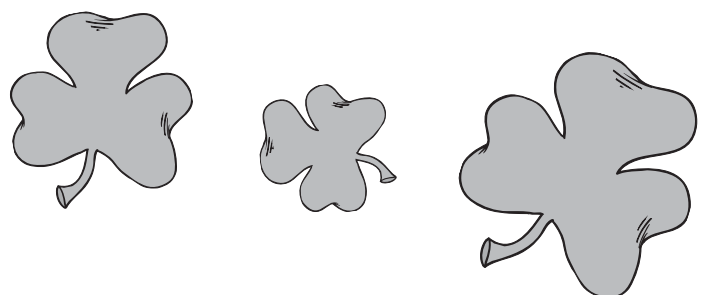
The building department has issued a building permit for the Northville Organic Food Co-op located at Heslip’s Corner (7 Mile & Napier Roads).

At their February meeting, the board of trustees authorized Stantec Consulting to begin the process of creating a master plan for the township’s 350 acre parcel on 7 Mile Road. The project will be developed over a 9-12 month period and include a significant community engagement component. We invite residents, business owners and community members to participate. Northville Downs hosts live racing on Friday and Saturday.

Long before Northville Downs became a reality (mid 1940's), Northville boasted a race track. At the turn of the century the property was purchased at Center and Seven Mile Road for a private nine hole golf course. A few years later a group of men, led by the late Ed Starkweather, started an "Athletic Park" on the site where harness racing occurred. Later, it was here that the Wayne County Fairgrounds were located. The building in the foreground is the then new electric light plant, having replaced the generator in the Globe furniture factory. This picture was taken shortly after the turn of the century.
