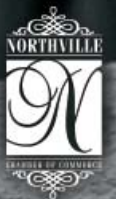

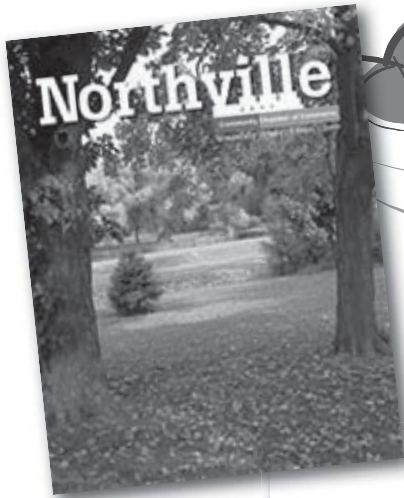

All-A-Glow Illumination for Education – December 2

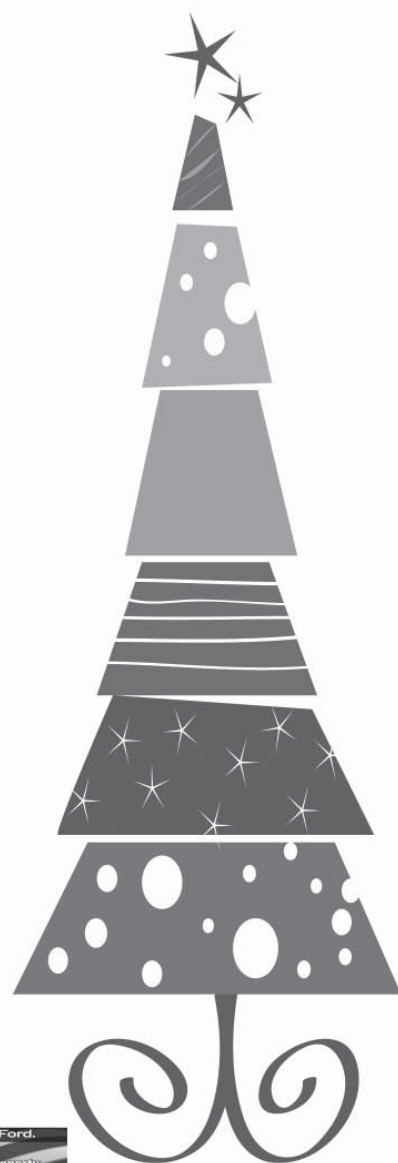
The Northville Mothers' Club will be lighting the tree in Old Church Square along with local school children singing many of our favorite holiday carols.

HVA PARAMEDIC RECEIVES NATIONAL RECOGNITION

The National Tactical Officers Association (NTOA) recently recognized Michigan State Trooper and Huron Valley Ambulance paramedic Ben Sonstrom with their Award of Excellence for his unselfish dedication to the enhancement of Tactical Emergency Medical Services (TEMS) programs.

TEMS teams provide preventive urgent and emergent medical care to police teams (more commonly known as SWAT teams) during high-risk and extended duration law enforcement special operations. TEMS providers develop medical threat assessments, render immediate medical care in high-risk environments, and provide logistical support during training and tactical operations. Their presence ensures the health and safety of police officers.

Sonstrom is a full time Michigan State Police trooper and a part time paramedic for HVA. Sonstrom received the award on September 22 at the Tactical Operations Conference in Richmond, Virginia.

2011 NORTHVILLE CITIZEN OF THE YEAR – WILLIAM S. DEMRAY DDS

Congratulations to the 2012 Northville Citizen of the Year, Dr. William S. Demray as announced at the Chamber Annual Meeting on October 19. Dr. Demray has been a dedicated and active member of the Northville community for over 30 years, and it is our honor to acknowledge his commitment and dedication to the Northville community.

Born and raised in Detroit, he received his undergraduate degree at Wayne State University and graduated from the University of Detroit as a Doctor of Dental Surgery. He opened his practice, Preservation Dental, in downtown Northville in 1977, and is described as a caring, excellent, dedicated professional. He found the historic property at 371 E. Main and decided to put his heart and soul into building an office that preserved the architecture and allowed his patients to feel “at home”. He realized that working in the same place he called home would mean his patients would be his neighbors and his neighbors would become his friends. The beauty of his office building has not gone unnoticed, receiving several City of Northville beautification awards.

But dentistry is just the tip of the iceberg, in his spare time he is also a pilot, photographer, craftsman and art lover. He is passionate about life and shares it with all who know him. His passion also extends to our community where for the past three decades he has dedicated his time and talents.

The list is long, but includes his appointments to the City of Northville Downtown Citizens District Council, the Downtown Development Authority, Planning Commission and the City Economic Development Corporation, and has been a member of the Chamber of Commerce for over 15 years.

He has served as a mentor to high school and college students, allowing them to volunteer and intern at his practice, and has donated his time and gifts to numerous causes, including home dental care for hospitalized patients, and those in nursing homes

Many community non profits have benefitted from his generosity opening his beautifully restored home at 800 Griswold for numerous fund raising events, including those held by the Northville Historical Society, Northville Art House, Tipping Pointe Theater and Northville AAUW, to name just a few.

He also embraces our traditions. His VW’s are always the highlight of our hometown parades and he hosts “afterglow” events featuring breakfasts, picnics, giveaways, and face painting. He knows how to have fun, and knows how to make those around him feel special.

His kind-hearted, enthusiasm is second only to his selfless dedication. His actions are true and honest; motivated by his love of community and his belief in the human spirit. A final example of this is the story of one of his patients telling him of a family member in hospice care. Our recipient made a house call to make a few dental adjustments so they could have a little joy in eating their favorite foods. A few days later the 9 year old granddaughter sent a “thank you” note simply saying... **“YOU ROCK”**.

So, we will echo that sentiment in congratulating our 2011 Citizen of the Year, **“YOU ROCK”** Dr. Demray.

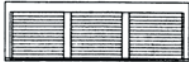

Business Licenses - All business establishments in the City of Northville are required to obtain a business license from the City. Information obtained through the license is helpful to the Police and Fire Department in case of an emergency after business hours. The yearly business license expires December 31st of each year. Renewal notices will be sent no later than mid-December. If a renewal notice has not been received, please contact the Clerk's office at (248) 349-1300.

Passports – New hours - The City of Northville is a passport application acceptance facility. Complete applications (including required documentation) are accepted Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. at the City of Northville Municipal Building, 215 W. Main Street. For information on the application process, including required documentation and fees, visit the City's website at www.ci.northville.mi.us (go to Services / Clerk / Passports) or call 248-349-1300 x1961.

Snow Removal - Snow on sidewalks is to be cleared within 24 hours of a snow or ice event. Additionally, please assist in the clearing of snow around a fire hydrant and storm water inlet.

 Building permits were issued for the following new businesses:

GIS Project Update - Prior to 2009, the township relied on Wayne County to maintain the township's parcel data and to update the tax maps whenever new residential lots were created or other changes to parcel boundaries occurred. Since 2009, the township has been doing the updates internally and has realized numerous benefits.

Parcel Updates - This involves reconstructing the legal description for every acreage parcel and platted lots using coordinate geometry (COGO) from the original plats and/or current legal descriptions and inputting the data into GIS. New parcel identification numbers are assigned by the township and information can be updated immediately after the change occurs. Of the township's 10,580 parcels, 6,032 have been updated.

Tax Maps - An extension of the parcel update project is recreating tax maps. In addition to lot dimensions, the township has added the following information to each tax map; increasing its usability and consolidating information into a singular location:

- Condominium streets
- Condominium/apartment buildings
- Acreage lot dimensions
- Storm water features
- Current PIN's for platted lot spits/combinations
- Ingress/Egress easements
- Subdivision names
- Water bodies and waterways

Upon completion, it is the goal of the township to publish this information to our website via a web browser. In addition to cost savings, other benefits realized by the township include:

- Instant map generation for future transactions
- Paperless retrieval for all employees
- Accurate parcel information for all township maps
- Digital archive for all platted lots
- Accurate R.O.W layer
- Display over aerial imagery
- All data centrally stored in GIS database

The Planning Department provides a monthly listing of all new development. The map is available on the township's website: www.twp.northville.mi.us, or from the Planning Department.

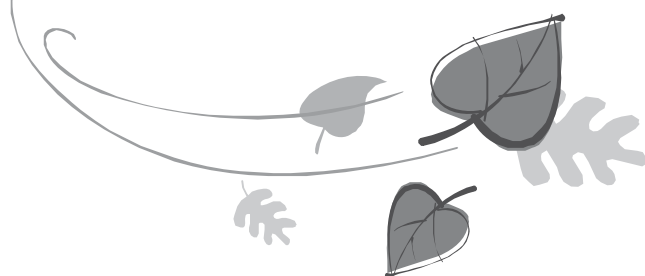
